When India beat Malaysia 3-2 in a thrilling quarter final tie at Bangkok, newspaper headlines read: **"Men's team beat Malaysia 3-2 to enter the semifinals, guaranteed of Bronze Medal".** This was the level of expectation. So, when the boys went on to beat **Denmark in the semifinals** and then **Indonesia in the final** (in straight games, too!!!), they had conquered all odds!

We, in India, have had badminton players of stature in the past: **Prakash Padukone**, **Pullela Gopinchand**. The present lot of players has not shown the kind of consistency displayed by those players in their careers, but in **Bangkok** this time, they pulled out all the stops and, boy, won the **Thomas Cup. Hurrah!**.

What is gratifying is the outlook on sports of the present ruling dispensation in Delhi. **The Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi** spoke to the team after their victory and as **H.S. Prannoy**, the captain of the team, recounted; he knew everything about each of the players, their names, their game, their fitness-status etc. **The Union Sports Minister Shri Anurag Singh Thakur** has announced a sum of **Rupees One Crore** to the team, and is peanuts compared to what our cricket "stars" make but is, nonetheless a good step. Now, the corporate sector must step in and announce their largesse to plug the gap, as it were!
