We just kickstarted our Season 10 training... with a motivational talk by Col.Sundaresan, an



ace marathoner who ran 52 marathons in 52 weeks to raise funds for Army welfare activities.

It all began 9 years ago when a group of 20 people assembled on the front lawn of Jolly Gymkhana and all had a dream... of running the Mumbai Marathon later that year. Capt. Swaminathan and Dr. Satish Balghat were the motivators for this group. When they approached Jolly Managing Committee the committee

was immediately excited about starting a fitness and long distance running program for its members... and thus was born the Marathon and Fitness group with training provided by the Gymkhana. That first year about 120 people ran the Mumbai Marathon after a 9 month



training.... And that was the largest group of runners from one gymkhana to run the Mumbai Marathon. And we can proudly say, to this day Jolly Gymkhana sends the single largest contingent of runners to Mumbai Marathon.

That first year all 120 ran half marathon, the 21 KM segment. Couple of years later we had about 4 people venturing into the full marathon, 42 KM segment. And

now about 16 of us run the full marathon and that number keeps increasing. Hetal Khatau, Capt.Swaminathan, Vipul Mehta and Dr. Falgun took part in one of the most gruelling. races



in the world the Comrades. Our runners have run around the world in various races So we have lots of things to be proud of. A small beginning... going strong in its 10th Anniversary.... and the best, we think, is yet to come.

The Ninth season was a power packed season. Started with a bang!! 3 of our runners completed Comrades. Some of us ran the Amsterdam and New York



Marathons. Ladakh, BNP, Satara, Hyderabad, Chennai, Bangalore and many other races saw Jolly flag flying high. Some among the Marathon and Fitness group also scaled the Everest Base Camp. Sweta Gada again got onto the victory stand by standing First in the 400 metres and 1500 metres race and third in the 100 metres race in the Maharashtra State Masters Athletics meet. 
